The most important thing we can do in this life is “to know the Father and His Son whom He sent.”

Not to know about Him but to have an intimate relationship with the Father and to see the revealing of the Father in His Son.

Our goal is not “to go to heaven.” Heaven is promised, but it is not the goal of our life.

God the Father’s predestined purpose was for Jesus to become the prototype and the firstborn of many who would become just like Him.

Hebrews 2:10 – “For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory...”

Jesus was/is:

1. The brightness of His glory (God is the sun, Jesus is the rays!)
2. The express image of His person – (The die of God’s exact image.)

For Jesus to bring “many sons to glory” means that He is bringing them to His likeness and image.

“But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.” (2 Cor. 3:18)

Faith is:

- Insight from God
- Agreement with God
- Obedience to God

“Once you have received a word from God, you obey that word, then you persevere despite the conflict that arises because of your obedience.”

These are Activation Principles

1. Hear and understand biblical truth (Logos, Rhema, Prophetic)
2. Believe in the Heart (Receive it)
3. Speak with the mouth (Agree with it)
4. Then obey based on that revelation (By the guidance of the Holy Spirit)

Read James 1:21-25

To look in the “Perfect Law of Liberty” is not for the purpose of finding what’s wrong about you. But you look in this perfect law to see “who you are” in Christ. And you have to continue in it, looking steadfastly until you “see yourself” or who you are by seeing what the Bible says about who you are. (Not what you are going to become!)

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We obey God three (3) ways:

- Allegiance
- Obedience
- Continuance

Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed on Him, if you continue in my word, then you are my disciples indeed; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. (John 8:31-32)

When Jesus was crucified, the enemy thought he had won. He actually thought he had succeeded in defeating the King of Glory. But what he didn't realize, he didn't kill Him. **He planted Him!**

John 12:24 –

“Verily, Verily, I say unto you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a seed, but if it dies, it bears much fruit.”

Satan cannot kill (destroy) the seed! ***Because Jesus (the Word) is incorruptible!***

1 Peter 1:23

“Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.”

That seed, in the right environment, brings forth trees that bear fruit that has seeds, that have trees that have fruit that has seeds, that has fruit, that has trees, that has fruit, that has seeds....

Satan (the great deceiver) and hinderer, can only try to thwart the progress of growth.

Mark 4, Matthew 13, Luke 8: All tell the story of the sower and the soils

1. Wayside – Not understanding / No revelation
2. Stony Ground – Doesn't take time to allow the roots to go deep
3. Among Thorns – Cares of this world, deceitfulness of riches, lust of other things enter in
